



The course Pre Hospital Life Support is a continuing training program designed in particular for pre-hospital workers (ambulance drivers, firefighters, nurses, doctors) but is accessible to any person who wishes to acquire knowledge in this field.

The PHTLS is designed according to the principle of the *evidence-based medicine* and emphasize the efficiency through a pragmatic approach first and foremost.

The PHTLS rely on the famous ATLS course and will give you the opportunity to improve your capacity to assess the severity of a patient's condition through an original pedagogical approach.

This training program revised every 4 years became a standard internationally recognized by all the pre-hospital staff. With a strong international structure, more than 800 000 pre-hospital workers have been trained for 30 years, in more than 64 countries.

**Target audience**

The training is designed for pre and in-hospital staff.

**Goal**

The goal of this training is to make capable of a systematic assessment of a traumatised patient in order to be able to manage priorities according to the principle of "Treat first what kill first", which support "critical thinking" encountered on the field.

**Location**

**Duration**

It's a 2 day-course with 16 hours of theoretical presentations, practical workshops and scenarios based on clinical situations.

- Airway management
- Assessment and management of ventilation

- Specificities of elderly and paediatric patients
- Burn care
- The principles of pre-hospital care for traumatised people
- Practical workshops (airway management, immobilisation)
- Practical simulations based on interactive scenarios



Upon successful completion of the course, the participants will receive a certificate valid for a period of 4 years.  
After that, they must attend a one day refresher course.
