



This degree course was developed by the NAEMT and the Committee of Prehospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS).

The training programme outlines the Emergency care Commission for the wounded in tactical situations (Co-TECC) and the programme of Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC).

The TECC uses the updated feedback from the military or police intervention forces and apply them to civilian life medicine in tactical situations.

Target Audience

For Emergency Medical Service professional, police officers, security staff.

Goal

The TECC is a medical and non-medical care of traumas in tactical situation (critical environment). This training is intended to adopt the right gestures to minimize the risk to caregivers and reduce the number of deaths.

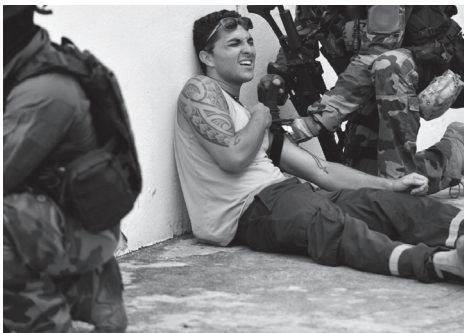
This approach gives the ability to provide care outside the normal operating conditions of most pre-hospital services, like being able to react to a large number of victims on the battlefield in so-called sensitive situations, terrorist attacks, hostile demonstrations or to cope with an active shooter.

Duration

It's a 2-day course, 16 hours including 3 theoretical hours and 13 hours of role-playing.

- Conduct under direct threat
- Indirect threat care
- Role-playing exercises
- Practical workshops:
 - Hemorrhage control
 - Airway control
 - Respiration/Breathing control, assessment MARCH(E)
 - Emergency extraction techniques



Upon successful completion of the course, the participants will receive a certificate valid for a period of 4 years.
After that, they must attend a one day refresher course.
